State of Emergency

Proclamation

In response to the risk that the COVID19 pandemic poses to the health and safety of the community and in accordance with the powers granted to me through Title 8, I am declaring that a state of emergency exists within the Borough of Mount Joy.

To ensure that essential Borough services are not adversely impacted by infection, access to Mount Joy Borough and Mount Joy Borough Authority facilities located within the Borough shall be restricted. Details concerning these restrictions will be determined and co-published with this declaration by the Borough Manager.

I would further encourage all guidelines regarding social distancing, non-essential services, and public gatherings published by the CDC and/or State of Pennsylvania be followed.

In keeping with the limited powers given to me through Title 8, this state of emergency shall remain in effect for a period of seven days unless sooner rescinded, modified, ratified or extended by resolution of Mount Joy Borough Council.
