

**Mount Joy Borough Parks Advisory
Board – Little Chiques Park Master Plan

6:30 PM, Tuesday, January 14, 2025**

- 1) Call to Order – 6:30 pm.
- 2) Roll Call— Christian, Morrison, Geltmacher, Deering, Zevallos
- 3) Consider a motion to approve the January 14, 2025, Meeting Agenda. – Motion by Christian 2nd by Zevallos, motion approved
- 4) Public Input Period - Comments of Any Borough Resident or Borough Property Owner. Time limit of three minutes will be strictly enforced. – Bill Hall recommended moving forward with pickleball courts and mentioned possible locations.
- 5) Approval of Minutes from December 10, 2024. (Note: November meeting canceled) – Motion by Christian 2nd by Zevallos, motion approved
- 6) YSM Consultant – Ann Yost/Chuck Strodoski
 - a) General updates – A public meeting is scheduled for January 29th at 6:30pm at Mount Joy Borough office.
 - b) Plan update – Christian brought the YSM’s drawing with some possible additions such as (signage, gravel walking trails) after a lengthy conversation Christian said he would send them to YSM for their thoughts. YMS will submit the plans to Borough Council February 3rd for comments.
- 7) Update on Streambank Restoration Project – Phase 1 to begin January 15th, phase 2 is out to bid (Rt.772 bridge to L.C. Park)
- 8) Discussion with possible recommendation regarding Pickleball Courts – The Advisory Board along with Mayor Bradley discussed in length possible locations, open play, courts in Manor Twp, Manheim Twp. Christian had maps of possible locations in our parks along with pros and cons of each location. Noise seems to be our biggest concern with picking a location along with where it would fit in with other amenities. Rotary would like to partner with Mount Joy to celebrate their 100th year which will be February 2026. The Advisory Board discussed Grandview Park, Borough Park and Rotary Park as three of the most likely parks to have courts, Christian will evaluate the pros and cons of each park, and we will present it to Borough Council
